Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim as being raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition, has already been allowed by this Court in the case of similarly situated employees namely Sh. O.P. Katyal and Sh. B.S. Kanwar and once the question of law has already been settled by this Court, the respondents are under obligation to grant the similarly situated employees, such as petitioner, the benefits, as extended to Sh. O.P. Katyal as well as Sh. B.S. Kanwar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction be issued to respondent No.1 to consider the case of the petitioner on the same terms as Sh. B.S. Kanwar, who has been the granted the benefit of restoration of commutation of pension.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 16.06.2019 (Annexure P-22) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 16.06.2019 (Annexure P-22), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 16.06.2019 (Annexure P-22), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
