Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.90 dated 18.08.2019 under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after filing of this petition the misunderstanding between the parties is over. Now the petitioner and the complainant are living together as husband and wife.

Counsel for the complainant, on instructions from the complainant, who is present in Court, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the complainant is staying with the petitioner in the matrimonial home.

In view of the above development, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 04.10.2019, whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is made absolute.

However, in case the presence of the petitioner is required in any manner by the police, a clear 15 days notice shall be given to him.
