Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the order dated 16.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) vide which the petitioner has been transferred from Jalandhar to Tarn Taran.

2. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.

3. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned transfer order dated 16.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) does not call for any interference from this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

3. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to pursue with the department by filing appropriate representation. It would

be appreciated that appropriate order is passed as expeditiously as possible on the representation deemed to be filed by petitioner.
