Main case

This revision petition is filed for issuance of direction to learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Bahadurgarh to get the order dated 10.9.2013 executed which has attained finality till Hon'ble Supreme Court within a time bound manner.

It is stated that even the order passed in the execution has attained finality upto the Hon'ble Supreme Court but inspite of the same the execution is not being carried out and the matter is being unnecessarily delayed. It is stated in the revision petition that the objections filed during execution were dismissed on 10.9.2013 and Local Commission was appointed to get the sale deed executed. The case was postponed to place on record the proposed sale deed on the file on the next date of hearing. However, instead of complying with this order, the

Judgment Debtors filed Civil Appeal No. 46 of 2013 which was dismissed on 9.11.2017. Judgment Debtors thereafter filed ESA No.73 of 2017 before the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court which was also dismissed on 9.1.2018. Even SLP No.24754 of 2018 was dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 15.2.2019 and order dated 10.9.2013 attained finality.

In view of the above and keeping in view the short prayer, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the Executing Court to dispose of the execution proceedings and take them to their logical end but in accordance with law within two months from the date already fixed before it.
