Prayer in the present writ petition is for directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to promote the petitioner from TGT to Postgraduate Teacher (PGT) from the date of promotion of other similarly situated junior teachers, i.e., 24.04.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner for promotion was espoused in legal notice (Annexure P-4), which is to be considered by respondent Nos.1 and 2. However, reply to the legal notice would not be considered for rejecting the claim.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.06.2019 (Annexure P-4) served by him, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the

present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 26.06.2019 (Annexure P-4) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is to be accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law and if the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

It is made clear that in case the legal notice is not decided within two months, there shall be costs of ₹ 25,000/- to be paid to the petitioner.
