Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.80 dated 13.08.2019 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Ramdass, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 Piar Kaur herself had purchased the property vide registered sale deed dated 23.06.2011, on making a payment of Rs.27.00 lacs to co-accused, whose anticipatory bail has already been dismissed. It is further submitted that petitioner No.1 Piar Kaur was not aware about title of the land and at the time, she purchased the property, she entered into an agreement and petitioner No.2 Jaspal Singh, who is son of petitioner No.1, is not a signatory.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of and the petitioners are granted the concession of anticipatory bail

subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to give a notice to the petitioners, if they are required for the purpose of investigation.
