The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.30 dated 18.04.2019 registered under Sections 307, 452, 364, 342, 323, 324, 341, 511, 506, 382, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Block Majri, Mohali District SAS Nagar.

It has been stated in the affidavit that the petitioner is not in possession of any Gram Panchayat land. It is further stated that the petitioner is not in possession of the land except the land owned by him. Additionally, counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, has stated that earlier the petitioner side was in possession of some Gram Panchayat land measuring 86.85 acres. However, in eviction proceedings, the side of the petitioner had lost the case. Accordingly, the possession was taken away from the side of the petitioner. Thereafter, the petitioner or any person from his side has never re-entered over the said land.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim direction granted vide order dated 04.10.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab, has not disputed the fact regarding petitioner's joining the investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 04.10.2019 is made absolute.
