Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.131, dated 07.10.2018, registered under Sections 302/365/34 IPC, at Police Station Tibba, Ludhiana.

Petitioner is an accused of killing her own younger brother. The entire case of the prosecution is based upon circumstantial evidence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the court to the statement of PW2-Ganesh Kanojia, who has not implicated the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that Lakhvinder Singh and Kashmir Singh are the persons before whom the petitioner had suffered disclosure statements.

Petitioner is in custody since 08.10.2018. Conclusion of the trial will take time. Petitioner is not involved in any other case as per the custody certificate.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 08.10.2018 months and

the trial of the case is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
