The petitioner claims that 36 persons, whose details have been given in para No. 4 of the petition, they have been illegally detained by respondents No. 5 to 7 at Brick Kiln, Marka TATA at Village Jatpur, Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur. The averments in the petition reflect violation of provisions of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976.

Notice of motion to AG, Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Prabhjot Singh Walia, AAG, Punjab accepts notice . Copy given.

The District Magistrate and Executive Magistrate seem to have power under Sections 12/21 of the said Act to take necessary action. No representation seems to have been filed by the petitioner before the District Magistrate, Hoshiarpur and Executive Magistrate concerned.

The petition is pre-mature.

Disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit a detailed representation to the District Magistrate, Hoshiarpur or Executive Magistrate concerned. In case any such representation is filed, the same will be entertained and decided within a period of 15 days on receipt of a copy of this order.
