In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that he suffered gun shot injury while in custody on 04.01.2017, due to which, his spinal cord has been damaged and he is not able to move and walk and is bed ridden.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner requires the treatment for spinal injury from a hospital but no facility is being provided, which is causing agony and pain to the petitioner. Learned counsel further states that petitioner is being transferred to another jail without looking into his medical condition and prays that petitioner should be granted medical facilities for the injuries, which he has suffered during the custody and he further prays that the petitioner be not transferred from District Jail, Yamunanagar keeping in view his health and injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief,

which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 18.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No. 3, which is still pending consideration with respondent No. 3 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Nidhi Garg, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. She raises no objection for the grant of prayer of the petitioner in deciding the representation in a time bound manner.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 3 is directed to decide the representation dated 18.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
