On 07.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 122 dated 5.9.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, Section 24 of Immigration Act at Police Station Meharban, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegations are against two sons of the petitioner and not against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupinder Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 06.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided

under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 07.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
