Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.224 dated 11.9.2019 registered under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that alleged recovery of 1000 intoxicant tablets Clovidol-100 SR is from Ashok Kumar @ Goldy and not from the petitioner. He, hence, submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated.

On reading of the FIR, it is apparent that petitioner is specifically named in the aforesaid FIR as a supplier of the drugs.

In view thereof, no ground to grant concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
