Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the fact that though an offence punishable under Section 307 of the IPC is alleged to have been committed by the petitioner and his co-accused, the injuries on the person of the complainant were found to be simple, with in fact a cross-version to the FIR also registered, in which the complainant is an accused; and further. that the matter has been compromised between all the accused and the complainant in the FIR in question, with a copy of the compromise deed having been annexed as Annexure P-4 with the petition.

That being so, without making any comment on the merits of the case for or against the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
