Petitioner is the legal heir of Shingara Singh, who has challenged the order dated 21.01.2011 and 09.03.2018 by which suit filed by Shingara Singh (deceased) under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 [for short 'the Act'] has been dismissed.

Although counsel for the petitioner has vehemently argued that the petitioner is in possession on the land in dispute since the year 1940 but he could not establish this fact with the aid of the revenue record which otherwise shows that the possession of the petitioner is from the year 1974 onwards.

Thus, in view thereof, there is hardly any merit in this case for the purpose of interference as we do not find any error in the impugned orders.

Dismissed.
