AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 20.10.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No. 22835 of 2012. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“The case of the petitioner is similarly situated with case of Indu Boken's case (Supra), therefore, the petitioner is also entitled for the same relief. Accordingly the petition is allowed. The service rendered by the petitioner from January 1969 to January 1979 in the Indian Navy is order to be counted for the purpose of pension. The petitioner shall deposit the amount received by him on account of gratuity or bonus on a discharge from the army. The said amount shall be calculated by the respondents and be intimated to the

petitioner within two weeks and the same be deposited by the petitioner within two weeks thereafter and then the arrears will be released to the petitioner within three months thereof.”

The respondents have filed the reply stating that the order passed by this court has been complied with as the service rendered by the petitioner in Indian Navy from January 1969 to January 1979 has been counted for the purpose of pension. The calculations were handed over to the petitioner for deposit of gratuity and pension, as per same the petitioner deposited the amount of gratuity and pension. Thereafter the respondents have released the arrears of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is grievance with regard to the arrears given by the respondents. He seeks liberty to avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.

Rule is discharged.

The contempt petition stands disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
