Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.121 dated 20.09.2019 under Sections 420, 120B IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Phase-8, District SAS Nagar.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Vide order dated 14.10.2019, interim bail was granted to the petitioner and he was directed to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh,

states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 14.10.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Sections 438(2) Cr.P.C.
