The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 50 dated 16.09.2019, under Sections 323, 325, 379, 511, 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that all the injuries, which are attributed to the petitioners, are simple in nature except for injury No. 4, which is a fracture on the hand of the complainant.

Heard.

It is manifest from the FIR that the petitioners have been specifically named therein and they along with 4-5 unknown persons had tried to commit theft of the trees. They were armed with iron rods and when they were stopped from committing theft, they had caused several injuries to the complainant. The MLR indicated that the complainant had received as many as eight injuries. In these circumstances, I do not deem it to be a fit

case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
