ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.88 dated 03.09.2019 registered under Sections 436 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was employed in a cloth shop and because of non-payment of salary, he had put the aforesaid cloth shop on fire.

The petitioner is in custody for a period of 1 month and 10 days. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Nasin Khan, has submitted that the investigations are complete and police would file the final report within a period of 10 days.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
