On 04.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.154 dated 7.9.2019 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Husband of the petitioner is alleged to have committed suicide.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that ingredients of Section 107 IPC read with Section 306 IPC are not made out from the reading of the FIR.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Additional Advocate General, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 19.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh,

has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation,

cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 04.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
