Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 203 dated 8.8.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station, City Moga, District Moga.

As per the allegations of the prosecution, petitioner had received a sum of Rs. 1,83,500/- with an assurance that daughter of the first informant on completion of O.E.T course would be immigrated to Australia.

As per the order passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga there are two more FIRs against the petitioner with similar allegations of duping innocent unemployed youth of their valuable money under the pretext of sending them abroad.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant pre-arrest bail is made out. Hence, dismissed.
