FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

On intervention by this Court, both Dr. Harshvardhan Sood and his wife Sunita Sood have agreed that the husband would be paying a sum of Rs.17,000/- per month as maintenance to the wife which would be paid in her bank account, particulars of which have been provided by learned counsel representing the wife to the husband in Court, preferably in the first week of every english calendar month. The husband undertakes that he would abide by this arrangement as long as he or she lives and in case any earlier amount is pending, the husband undertakes to clear the same in installments which would be paid in equated monthly installments every month. The husband has also made statement that he would withdraw divorce petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu

Marriage Act, 1955 against the wife immediately and the wife has also made similar statement that she will also withdraw her cases so pending in different courts. The couple has further undertaken that they will not institute any other civil or criminal case against each other or lay any other claim arising out of this matter/marriage.

In the light of this settlement, learned counsel for the applicant on instructions from his client has made statement withdrawing the present transfer application.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
