This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to take action against respondent No.3, who is raising illegal and unauthorized construction for the purpose of running a factory/hosiery for commercial use.

On oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab, is impleaded as respondent No.4. Registry is directed to make the necessary corrections in the memo of parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.4-Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 13.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl. A.G., Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 13.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
