Present petition has been filed under Section 340 Cr.P.C. read with 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to initiate appropriate inquiry against respondent No.2 and for further punishing him by taking appropriate legal action against him for committing perjury while deliberately misrepresenting before this court in the course of filing of CRM-M No.47699 of 2018.

Although, the petition filed by the petitioner and the arguments raised by the counsel for the petitioner, seem to have some substance, however, this court does not deem it appropriate to initiate the proceedings under Section 340 Cr.P.C. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other remedy, in accordance with law, if deemed appropriate by him. Still further it is clarified that in case the petitioner avails his any other

remedy, then the dismissal of the present petition shall not be taken adverse to him in any manner; whatsoever.
