HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 121, dated 10.8.2019, registered under Section 27 (a) of NDPS Act, 1985 at PS. Sirhali, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case, though no recovery was effected from his possession and he was not named in FIR even. The learned counsel further states that he has been arrayed as as accused for harbouring the main accused and he is ready to join investigation.

Vide order dated 4.10.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh states that petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 4.10.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
