The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.0158, dated 22.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Division C, Amritsar, District Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 04.10.2019, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Area Judicial Magistrate for recording their statements and the trial Court/Area Judicial Magistrate was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report dated 20.11.2019 has been received from the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0158, dated 22.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Division C, Amritsar, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners.
