On 04.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 8 dated 11.1.2019 registered under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on vide DDR No. 31 dated 13.7.2019) at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR in question has been got registered after a considerable delay and the petitioner is alleged to have given injury with iron rod on the right leg of the injured.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Additional Advocate General, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 14.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mahesh Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 04.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
