Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to give him appointment against the post of Lecturer Pharmacy advertised by Punjab Public Service Commission, Patiala vide advertisement No.8 (Annexure P-1) in the Category of Balmiki/Majbhi Sikh.

2. In the premise, petitioner submitted a representation dated 14.08.2019 (Annexure P-7), but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Mr. P.S.Bajwa, Additional A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no

necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 14.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. It would be appreciated while disposing of the writ petition, respondents may look into the judgments rendered by Apex Court in case titled as ***State of J & K and others Vs. Sat Pal, 2013 (11) SCC 737*** as also by this Court in case titled as ***Navkirat Singh Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 09.02.2017 vide CWP No.83 of 2017***, which as per learned counsel for the petitioner are squarely applicable in favour of the petitioner.
