Learned counsel for respondent No.1 states that vide order dated 10.10.2019 the execution has since been dismissed as withdrawn being fully satisfied. Its copy has been placed on record as Annexure R-1. A perusal of the order dated 10.10.2019 shows that respondents no. 7 and 8 have suffered a statement that in compliance of the order of the Court, the allotment of Unit No.402, Sector 15, Omax City, Delhi Road, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar has been transferred in favour of the decree holders i.e. respondents No. 1 and 2 Mandeep and Deepika and the decree holders have suffered a statement that they will get the sale deed registered in view of the letter dated 25.09.2019 issued by respondents No. 7 and 8 and have withdrawn the execution petition.

In view thereof this revision petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.
