The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to inquire into complaint dated 26.5.2019 and to register a case against respondent No.4 under the relevant provisions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was married to respondent No.4-Rahul on 9.3.2015 and although huge dowry was given at the time of marriage to respondent No.4 and other members of his family, but they were not satisfied with the same and started harassing and beating the petitioner which forced the petitioner to leave her matrimonial home on 26.5.2019.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Assistant Police Commissioner, Amritsar, District Police Head Quarters, Civil Line, Amritsar (respondent No.3) to ensure that representation dated 26.5.2019 (Annexure P-1) is got looked into and in case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 be sent to Assistant Police Commissioner, Amritsar, District Police Head Quarters, Civil Line, Amritsar (respondent No.3), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
