The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.65 dated 20.07.2017, under Sections 302, 307, 324, 120-B, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran.

It is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner has raised a 'lalkara'. He has not attributed any injury. He was found innocent during investigation and has been summoned on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 07.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and submit his regular bail bonds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 09.10.2019 and submit his regular bail bonds in terms of the order dated 07.10.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 07.10.2019 granting bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
