[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation, Annexure P-6 dated 01.02.2019 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the instant writ petition but that no action has been taken in respect thereto till date and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-6 dated 01.02.2019 in accordance with law.
