Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced in Court today copies of the testimonies of the deposition of both the complainant and his daughter (who is stated to be the alleged victim), completely denying that the petitioner had committed any offence as regards the victim.

Though learned State counsel admits that both the aforesaid witnesses have turned hostile, he submits that even as per the FSL report and the DNA examination, the semen stains were found to be matching with the sample given by the petitioner.

He further submits that the victim is admittedly less than 18 years of age.

That being so, with the victim stated to be only 15½ years old, with the petitioner being 27 years of age and not a teenager, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, I see no reason to entertain this petition, at this stage.

Dismissed at this stage.
