Application has been filed for bringing on record the legal heirs of deceased appellant No.1 Savitri Mehta. It is stated that the said appellant had expired on 17.06.2013 leaving behind her legal heirs as mentioned in para No.3 of the application, who are stated to be the only legal heirs of deceased appellant. It is further stated that there are no other legal heirs of the deceased appellant except ones mentioned in para No.3 of the application.

Accordingly, in view of the averments made in the application, duly supported by affidavit of Vinod Mehta son of deceased-appellant, same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Legal heirs as mentioned in para

No.3 of the application are brought on record and permitted to pursue the present litigation only. It is made clear that the present order will not be liable to be taken into consideration in any other set of proceedings.

CM stands disposed of.

Main case

In view of the detailed reasons assigned in RFA No.725 of 2016, titled as **State of Haryana and others Vs. Sohan Lal and another**, the appeal filed by the landowners is allowed, for the second notification dated 10.12.2008 and 30% severance charges of the market value is granted.
