Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.69 dated 6.8.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner had inflicted two blows with datar to the injured aimed at his head but landed on the right hand as the injured tried to save his head. The injury on the right hand has been declared grievous in nature. Injured was under the influence of medicines and sedatives due to which he was not fit to make statement for a period of 4-5 days from the date of occurrence.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
