On 04.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No.79 dated 20.04.2019 registered under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, City Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is working as A.S.M. with M/s Nahid Foil Private Limited and in that capacity dealt with the first informant who was purchasing the products of the company. He further submits that the petitioner has not received any amount in his own account. He also submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr.SPS Tinna, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice.

A copy of the petition be handed over to learned counsel for the State, during the course of the day.

List on 01.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However,

the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 04.10.2019 is made absolute.
