By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of the impugned order dated 03.04.2018 (copy Annexure P-1), by which they have been declared to be proclaimed persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioners reiterates that the criminal complaint in the context of which the petitioners have been declared to be proclaimed persons, has itself been withdrawn by the complainant, as reflected in the order of the learned trial Court dated 22.02.2019 (copy Annexure P-5).

Notice of motion having been issued, learned State counsel appears but despite service on respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant before the trial Court, he has not appeared.

Thus, with the complaint itself having been withdrawn in the context of which the petitioners were declared to be 'proclaimed persons', the petition is allowed, with the impugned order set aside.

Further consequently, FIR No. 521 dated 28.04.2018, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 174-A of the IPC, is hereby quashed, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom.
