On 07.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 154 dated 15.3.2019 registered under Section 408 IPC at Police Station, Palam Vihar, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was only a junior employee working under first informant and he has been falsely implicated in the case by levelling highly improbable allegations.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 01.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar,

has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation,

cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 07.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
