Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the District Magistrate, Palwal to issue in his favour an Arms License under the category of N.P.B Pistol.

Instant writ petition had come up for hearing before a Coordinate Bench on 14.10.2019 and the following order was passed:-

*“Mr. Surjit Bhadu, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to enable the petitioner to make a fresh representation setting out the full facts in the light of the doubts raised by Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana.
Adjourned to 29.10.2019.”*

Counsel representing the petitioner makes a statement that a fresh representation setting out the complete facts/claim has been furnished to learned State counsel. He undertakes that a complete copy would also be submitted in the office of the District Magistrate concerned within a period of two days.

Learned State counsel makes a statement that the representation would be examined by the competent authority and a final decision thereupon in accordance with law would be taken within a period of two

weeks from today and the same would be conveyed to the petitioner.

In the light of such statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant writ petition, at this stage.
