The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.52 dated 05.08.2012, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is merely named in the FIR and no overt act has been attributed to him. He also contends that co-accused, who were named in the FIR, were acquitted by the trial Court at the conclusion of the trial. He also contends that the petitioner was erroneously declared as 'proclaimed offender' though he was not served at the address where he was residing. He also contends that the petitioner has preferred a petition for quashing the proceedings declaring him as 'proclaimed offender'. He also contends that he does not press this petition at this stage as the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and prefer an application for regular bail which may be ordered to be decided expeditiously.

The petition is dismissed as not pressed. In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously.
