[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-4) dated 27.05.2019 to respondent No.4 and although respondent No.4 has forwarded the same to respondent No.3 to take appropriate action in the matter but no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent Nos.3 & 6 to treat the writ petition as a representation and to decide the claim of the petitioner in accordance with the rules & regulations applicable besides take such further action as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case.

[2] Notice of motion to respondent Nos.3 & 6 only.

[3] On the asking of the Court, Mr. Nishant Maini, assisting counsel to Mrs. Anu Chatrath Kapur, learned Senior Advocate and Mr. Dheeraj Jain, assisting counsel to Mr. Satya Pal Jain, learned Additional Solicitor General of

India, accept notice on behalf of respondent Nos.3 & 6 respectively and state that they have no objection to the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

[4] In view of the statement of counsel for the parties, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent Nos.3 & 6 to consider the claim of the petitioner as made in the writ petition and to decide the same as per rules & regulations applicable and take such further action in the matter as may be warranted in the facts & circumstances of the case as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 02 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order along with copy of the writ petition.
