Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in complaint case No.COMA 2955/2015 dated 20.10.2015, registered under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, read with Section 420 IPC.

Petitioner is an accused in criminal complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. He after having been released on bail, stopped appearing and was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 04.10.2016. The petitioner was granted indulgence. The petitioner was permitted to appear before the trial Court but once again he absented. The Court has noticed that the petitioner has been adopting delay tactics to linger on the case. Learned Additional Sessions Judge, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate within 3 days and apply for bail which shall be decided by the Court within 3 days.

In view thereof, no ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.
