In the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No.4 to 6, who are parents of petitioner No.2 on account of their marriage which has taken place on 30.09.2019 as per Hindu Rites and Ceremonies. Photographs of marriage and copy of the marriage certificate are appended as Annexure P-3 and P-4.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 01.01.1985 as per Aadaar Card (Annexure P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 01.01.1994. Affidavit of petitioner No.2 has been appended as Annexure P-2. It has been averred that both the petitioners belong to same caste.

A representation dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Vibha Tiwari, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy of paper-book be supplied to her.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the *Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478*, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
