Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for search and release of detenues named in paragraph 4 of the petition.

State Counsel, on instructions from Roshan Lal, Labour Inspector, Sonapat and HC Pawan Kumar, has submitted that the raid was conducted and the detenues were not found in illegal detention.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

The alleged detenues were alleged to be working in a brick kiln. The District Magistrate of the district is the authority specifically authorized under Section 10 of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976, to deal with such cases. Hence, petitioners shall be at liberty to move an application before the concerned District Magistrate.

Disposed of accordingly.
