On 01.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 22.06.2019 registered under Sections 379, 420, 447, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner being co-sharer in the joint land had sold a plot to Nachattar Singh which was strictly within his share. He further submits that Vipul Goel-First Informant had also purchased 20 kanals of land in the year 2011 from undivided khata. Hence, he submits that without partition of the property by metes and bounds, every co-owner is deemed to be owner of every parcel of land.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurpreet Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 01.11.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
