The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 82 dated 15.07.2019, registered under Sections 379, 420 of the IPC at Police Station Phase-8, Mohali.

The operative part of the order dated 14.10.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Simranjit Singh, it is stated that he is a doctor and on receiving the telephonic call from a person namely Ravinder, the complainant went to pick him up from Bus Stand, Sector-43, Chandigarh. From there, the said person was brought to his hospital and after one and half hour, the complainant found that said Ravinder has committed theft of his car along with certain other documents. It is further submitted that name of the petitioner is Gurwinder Singh and as per the FIR, the person named as Ravinder was already known to the complainant and therefore,

identify of the petitioner is in dispute. It is also submitted that the car has already been recovered.

Notice of motion for 19.11.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 14.10.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Amandeep Kaur, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the car has been recovered and he is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 14.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
