This writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take appropriate action against Subhash Singh Sarpanch and Gram Sachiv Manoj who have caused huge financial loss to the govt. in connivance with the private persons as pointed out by the petitioner vide his representations.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar to consider and decide the representation dated 28.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Ayuwan Singh, A.A.G., Haryana in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar to consider and decide the representation dated 28.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
