Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 174 dated 7.7.2018 registered under Sections 341, 365, 323 IPC (Sections 342, 34, 302, 326 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act added later on) at Police Station Sarangpur, Chandigarh.

Petitioner is in custody for 1 year 2 months and 21 days. As per the medical evidence, the cause of death is diabetes. Prosecution as on now has examined only two witnesses out of total 31 proposed to be examined. Conclusion of the trial is likely to take time. Petitioner is not involved in any other case as per the custody certificate.

In similar bail petitions filed by the co-accused vide CRM-M-61939-2018, M-36926-2018, M-38756-2019 and M-39551-2019, concession of regular bail has been granted to them.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in

view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
