Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.240 dated 23.8.2019 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station, Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner as a General Power of Attorney has sold immovable property/plot which belongs to the Wakf Board.

Learned counsel for the complainant/first informant has submitted that large number of similar cases have been registered and the petitioner admitting his mistake had undertaken to refund the amount which has also not been paid.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not

find it appropriate to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.
