In the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No. 4 & 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 31.08.2019 as per Hindu Rites and Ceremonies at Arya Samaj Mandir (Regd.) Amritpuri-B, East of Kailash, New Delhi. The marriage certificate and photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 21.05.1997 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 13.02.1998 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2).

A representation dated 28.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) has also been moved to respondent No.2 in this regard.

State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
