Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.56 dated 14.03.2019, registered under Sections 307/427/120-B/34 IPC and Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon an order passed in CRM-M-30516-2019, decided on 24.07.2019(**Subhash vs. State of Haryana**).

Learned State counsel does not dispute that the role attributed to the petitioner is similar to Subhash, who has been granted concession of regular bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and Keeping in view the reasons recorded in the order dated 24.07.2019, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
